

## Castration Discharge Instructions

Confinement: Please keep indoors for the next 7 to 10 days.

Bathing: None for seven days.

Medication: Pain medication was given

Diet: Routine

Lab Results: Ok for anesthesia

Next Appointment: No suture removal is necessary.

Special Instructions: Watch for swelling of the incision, drainage or excessive licking. Keep from jumping as much as possible.

General Information: He has just been confined in our hospital and has received the best care we are capable of giving. He may not have eaten or drank as he would at home and, therefore, may seem to be overly hungry and thirsty. Do not overfeed or give excessive amounts of water, as this may cause vomiting.

**HE HAS UNDERGONE SURGERY.** Do not allow excessive playing, jumping or running. This may delay the healing process. If you observe any drainage from the incision sites, please call the clinic immediately for advice on further care. If he chews or scratches at the surgery areas, please attempt to discourage this, as it may cause the incision to open. If this occurs please call the office to pick up an e-collar.

The above recommendations from our staff are to insure your pet's safety.
